They will also develop more advanced skills such as dictation, translation and spontaneous talk.	At the end of the half-term students will sit an end of year exam, covering all of the vocabulary and grammar they have learnt this year. The end of year exam will assess all of the big ideas: reading, listening and writing.	Literacy: Students will revisit and consolidate all of the grammar points covered to date. Numeracy: Students will practice time and numbers, these are topics which students often find challenging and will require consolidation. Thinking Skills: Students will take part in a range of paired and group-work activities to develop their team- work skills.
